Code of Behaviour for Bar/Bat Mitzvahs

1. All children are to stay within the boundaries of the Bar/Bat Mitzvah area. No disturbing of hotel guests when party is held in a hotel.
2. To be respectful at all times during the Bar/Bat Mitzvah. i.e. **staying quiet during religious services and speeches.**
3. No vandalism of property or violence of any kind will be tolerated. i.e. writing or drawing on any decorations, photos, posters
4. No swearing or rudeness.
5. No consumption of alcohol.
6. No other socially unacceptable behaviour will be tolerated.
7. Parents are encouraged to attend shul with their child and are asked to be sensitive to differing synagogue norms around Kiddush luncheon participation and sponsorship.
8. After parties usually involve only the students, so please refer to the invitation to confirm.

Each student enrolled in the OJCS B'nai Mitzvah Program must adhere to the standards set forth. If a child is found not in compliance with the code of behaviour, as well as being sent home early from an event, the child will be suspended from the program for a period of six months. The suspension will allow each family in the program the option of not inviting the suspended child or children without penalty of losing their own child's bond. If a second occurrence should occur the child will be expelled from the program permanently. Please review this with your child. The signed code of behaviour is to be handed in together with the OJCS B'Nai Mitzvah Program participation form. No one will be accepted into the program without all of the required forms. As well no one will be accepted into the program after the deadline stated, with the exception to new students to the grade/class.
