

Special Resource Teacher Grades 4-8

- Working in partnership with parents to arrange supports and assessments for students;
- Reading psycho-educational assessments, and other assessments, when needed;
- Participating in IEP meetings with In-School Team and parents;
- Supporting teachers with planning and carrying out accommodations and modified programming for their students;
- Providing behaviour management intervention;
- Assisting with Executive Functioning lagging skills;
- Locating and providing resources for classroom teachers;
- Listening to teachers regarding their students' needs and suggesting strategies and interventions;
- Writing Resource Reports to ensure students and parents are aware of progress and areas for growth;
- Providing students with Quiet Rooms for tests and exams;
- Working knowledge and offering support with delivery of CAT-4 assessment.
