

HEAD OF SCHOOL – Ottawa Jewish Community School

THE SCHOOL:

In 1949, a group of visionary Ottawa parents founded Hillel Academy to meet the growing need for a pluralistic Hebrew day school. Guided by Rabbi Baruch Kravetz, the school quickly became a cornerstone of Jewish life in the city. Rooted in core Jewish values—Tzedakah, Tikkun Olam, heritage, and a love of Israel—Hillel offered a high-quality trilingual education (English, French, Hebrew) that empowered students to thrive.

After moving through several locations, the school found its permanent home in the 1980s at 31 Nadolny Sachs Pvt., now part of the Ottawa Jewish Community Campus. In 2009, the school was renamed the Ottawa Jewish Community School (OJCS), continuing its legacy of excellence and community leadership.

With 193 students enrolled in 2024-2025, diverse and inclusive, OJCS remains a vibrant reflection of the community it serves. Learn more at www.theojcs.ca
